DOWC EDI Claims Release 3.1 Clarification on DN0052 Employee Date of Birth for MTC UR

The Colorado Division of Workers' Compensation would like to provide clarification regarding the use DN0052 Employee Date of Birth as a match data element for EDI Claims R3.1 reporting.

The Element Requirement Table for **FROI MTC UR (Update Report)** indicates that DN0052 Employee Date of Birth is a required match data element and is applicable for Colorado EDI Claims R3.1 reporting. However, the Edit Matrix Match Data Table did not include the applicable indicator in the MTC UR Legacy Claim (**Claims reported in Release 1**) column for the DN0052 Employee Date of Birth row. **This omission will be corrected in a future update to the published documentation.**

Please note that DN0052 Employee Date of Birth remains a valid match data element for MTC UR. Trading partners should ensure that DN0052 Employee Date of Birth values reported on transactions are consistent with the corresponding legacy claim information.

If Colorado identifies claims where the reported DN0052 Employee Date of Birth does not match the DN0052 Employee Date of Birth associated with the legacy claim, affected trading partners may be contacted to discuss any additional actions that may be necessary.

We appreciate your attention to this clarification and will provide updated documentation as soon as it becomes available.
